The Holy Land & Rome

Day 1 Fri Mar 25: MIAMI - EUROPE. Group members gather at the ticket counter at the airport two hours prior to our departure to Europe. Dinner and breakfast will be served in-flight.

Day 2 Sat Mar 26: EUROPE - TEL AVIV. Upon our arrival at the Tel Aviv airport we are met and transferred to our hotel in Herzlia - situated on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. Dinner is served at our hotel. Weather permitting; we suggest a walk on the beach.

Day 3 Sun Mar 27: HERZLIA - GALILEE. After a good nights rest and a hearty breakfast, we begin the thrilling journey of following in the footsteps of Jesus. Ancient Joppa on the Sea is where Jonah set sail, and where Peter raised Dorcas from the dead. Joppa was also the home of Simon the Tanner. At Caesarea by the sea we visit the Crusader's Castle, the Roman Amphitheater, water duct and the port from which the Apostle Paul sailed to Rome. Driving through the Jezreel Valley we visit Megiddo and continue to the fields of Armageddon (*Revelation 16:16*). We then continue northward along the Mediterranean Sea to Haifa and Mt. Carmel - the biblical site of Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (*I Kings 18*). Turning eastward across Galilee, we view Mt. Tabor (*Psalms 89:12*), Deboriya - the hometown of the prophetess Deborah - at the foothill of Mt. Tabor (*Judges 4 and 5*). Overnight at our hotel on the shores of the beautiful Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 Mon Mar 28: TIBERIAS - CAPERNAUM - CAESAREA PHILIPPI - MT. HERMON - GOLAN HEIGHTS. This day will be an exciting day in the Galilee area after a delicious breakfast. We depart the Roman hot springs resort city of Tiberias via boat across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum (*John 6:24*) to walk among the ancient ruins of the first century synagogue where Jesus preached (*Matthew 4:13-17*). Then on to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the "Sermon on the Mount" (*Matthew 5-7*) and to Tabgha - the chapel dedicated to the multiplication of the loaves and fishes - (*Mark 6:34-44*). We then proceed to upper Galilee and the site of Peter's confession (*Matthew 16:16*) at Caesarea Philippi, Mt. Hermon (*Psalms 89:12*) - the probable site of the Transfiguration (*Matthew 17:1-8*) - and the present day Golan Heights where Israel, Lebanon and Syria come together. We then follow the fresh mountain waters of Mt. Hermon to the Sea of Galilee and to the outlet passage at

the southern tip of the Sea where we stop at the beautiful Pilgrims Park on the Jordan River. Time available for a baptism by the Pastor. Return to our hotel for overnight.

Day 5 Tue Mar 29: NAZARETH - JERICHO - JERUSALEM. Early morning departure to Cana and then on to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus, where we visit the Church of the Annunciation (*Luke 1:5-42*) and Mary's Fountain (*Luke 4:16-22*). We continue to Beth She'an and then south through the Jordan Valley to ancient Jericho where the walls came tumbling down (*I Kings 17:1-6 and II Kings 2:19-22*) and a commanding view of the Mt. of Temptation (*Matthew 4:1-11*) and Elisha's Fountain. Then up to Jerusalem through the Judean wilderness. Overnight at our hotel in the Holy City of Jerusalem.

Day 6 Wed Mar 30: JERUSALEM. After a night of rest and a hearty breakfast this exciting day begins with a drive to Mt. Scopus and the Mt. of Olives (*Matthew 24:3*) for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Here, we visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Church of Pater Noster and the Dominus Flevit. We then walk along Hosanna Road to Gethsemane and visit the Church of All Nations that stands on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed by Judas (*Matthew 26:36-57*). See the Pillar of Absalom, the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple. We then drive to Mt. Zion where we visit the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu, Mt. Zion, King David's Tomb, Room of the Last Supper, Hebrew University, and the Model City of Jerusalem which depicts in miniature the Holy City as it appeared in the first century. We visit the Martin Luther King Memorial and the Ethiopian Church. Afterwards, we continue to tour New Jerusalem: see Yad Vashem - the immensely moving memorial to the six million martyrs of the Holocaust. Return to our hotel for overnight.

Day 7 Thu Mar 31: JERUSALEM - BETHLEHEM. Today begins with a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Starting at the Western (Wailing) Wall where the faithful Jews cry their petitions to God, we proceed to the Temple Area of Mt. Moriah. Visit the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock that was built on the ancient site of Solomon's Temple (*Genesis 22:9-14*) and over the Rock of Sacrifice where Abraham offered Isaac (*Genesis 22*) and the ceremonial sacrifice of animals took place. After this, we walk along the Via Dolorosa to Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, the Ecce Homo Arch (*John 19:13*) where Jesus was tried before Pilate (*Mark 15:6*). Then continue through the Old City bazaars to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Visit the Garden Tomb and Golgotha - Place of the Skull - for a

worship service. This afternoon, we continue our tour to Bethlehem. We visit the Church of the Nativity - the birthplace of Jesus, Shepherds Fields (*Luke 2:1-20*) and the Field of Boaz and Ruth (*Ruth 1:16-17 & 4:13*). We return to Jerusalem passing Rachel's Tomb (if viewable) to our hotel for overnight.

Day 8 Fri Apr 1: MASADA - DEAD SEA - QUMRAN - BETHANY. This morning we drive via the Judean Desert to the Dead Sea - the lowest point on earth. Continuing on, a beautiful new road takes us south along the shore of the Dead Sea to Masada, a truly remarkable piece of history. We ascend Masada by cable car to walk among the magnificent ruins of the fortress where, from 70-73 A.D., the Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean Revolt against Rome and where the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a sixth century Byzantine church are still on view. Return along the Dead Sea to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Visit the remains of the Community Center of the Essenes and the Caves of the Scrolls. We continue on the Jericho Road viewing the Inn of the Good Samaritan (*Luke 10:25-37*). On the return to Jerusalem we visit Bethany, the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus (*John 11:1-46*). On to our Jerusalem hotel for overnight.

Day 9 Sat Apr 2: JERUSALEM - TEL AVIV - ROME. This morning, we travel to Tel Aviv for some sightseeing including ancient Joppa. After lunch, continue to the Tel Aviv airport for our departure to Rome, Italy. Dinner served aboard aircraft. Overnight at our hotel in Rome.

Day 10 Sun Apr 3: ROME. A morning visit to the Vatican City includes the Museum, the Sistine Chapel, St. Peter's Square, Church of St. Peter, Basilica of St. Paul, the ancient Appian Way and the catacombs of St. Calixtus. Some time this afternoon at leisure for shopping or other pursuits on our own.

Day 11 Mon Apr 4: ROME. Time at leisure this morning for activities of our own. Afternoon sightseeing includes Moses' Fountain, Quirinale Palace, Pantheon, Roman Forum, Arch of Titus, the Coliseum - site of early Christian martyrdom - and Mamertine Prison, possibly the final place of confinement of the Apostle Paul before his execution. Return to our hotel for dinner overnight.

Day 12 Tue Apr 5: ROME - MIAMI. Transfer to the airport for our return flight home - the end of a most enjoyable journey.
